 - i. Donations to this organization are not tax deductible
- c. Revisit bylaws in future once officers are elected to potentially include
 - i. Definition of terms
 - ii. Conditions for removal due to confidence

 - iii. Treasurer: Mike Senters nominated by Howard Schwahlbach; accepted, vote carries

- e. Question by Rick Gregory – what is KYSCA goal?
 - i. State shoots should be up to the clubs
 1. Meal, trophy, gift cards - ~\$10k invested in state shoot
 - ii. Stewards of targets fees
 - iii. Advocate for shooters
