

# Determining a Kentucky State Champion

in the event of natural disaster, act of God or situation beyond control

## Contingency Plan

If the main event of the Kentucky State Championship is shortened due to the occurrence of any natural disaster, act of God or event beyond the direct, immediate control of KYSCA/ (CLUB NAME) the following procedure will be used to establish the Kentucky State championship results.

1. A Kentucky State champion will not be named unless all competitors have shot at least 100 main event targets.
2. The total score shot from all competitors plus the addition of 100 targets for the remaining course not shot will be the raw score to determine the final results.
3. Should there be ties for CH, RU and 3<sup>rd</sup> we will move to the shoot-off field to attempt a 10-target shoot-off. Competitors will shoot 10 targets until all ties have been broken to establish the Champion, Runner Up, and third. Winners will be determined solely on the score of the 10 target shoot-off.
4. First place ties in all classes and concurrent will be determined by a 10 target shoot off in the corresponding field to determine Class and Concurrent champion. Winners will be determined solely on the score of the 10 target shoot-off.
5. 2<sup>nd</sup> – 4<sup>th</sup> in Class and 2<sup>nd</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup> Concurrent will be decided by tie breaker process.
6. The shoot-off for champion, runner-up and third place will be held, weather permitting, on Sunday of the Kentucky State Sporting Clays Championship in the determined Shoot-off area at approximately 30 min after the last rotation on Sunday.
7. The shoot-off for first place ties in all classes and concurrent will be held, weather permitting, on Sunday of the Kentucky State Sporting Clays Championship at approximately 15 min after the CH, RU and 3<sup>rd</sup> shoot off.
8. If these above-mentioned shoot-offs cannot be held on Sunday evening due to the occurrence of any natural disaster, act of God or event beyond the direct, immediate control of KYSCA/ (CLUB NAME) Championship title will not be awarded. Class money will be awarded based on tie breaker stations.
9. Any shooter who is not present 10 minutes before the shoot-off shall forfeit his or her position. The position will not be filled by any alternates.
10. All other placements will be decided by total score of targets attempted plus addition of 100 targets.
11. The above will be followed for Out of State competitors if applicable.
12. The KYSCA/(CLUB NAME) will together decide on any clarification to the above contingency plan as needed.

## **Side Events**

If the side events of the Kentucky State Sporting Clays Championship are shortened due to the occurrence of any natural disaster, act of God or event beyond the direct, immediate control of KYSCA/(CLUB NAME) the following procedure will be used to establish the champion, as well as Class and Concurrent champions from shooters who have completed the events.

1. All awards will be based on scores of competitors who complete the event
2. If no shooters complete the event, no awards or punches will be provided.
3. All side events will be determined by tie breaker stations.
4. Any events not shot will be refunded.
5. Final say is at the discretion of the Host Club.

## **Main Event Payout Options**

**Option A:** Main event prize money will be paid in full as advertised and no refund for targets not shot in the Kentucky State Championship will be dispersed.

**Option B:** Main event prize money will be paid at 50% of advertised payouts and shooter will receive 50% of Kentucky State Championship entry fee as a refund.

## **Side Event Payout Options**
